Pledge of Allegiance:

Mayor Grenke led everyone in the pledge of allegiance.

MAYORAL APPOINTMENTS:

Mayor Grenke appointed David Lucas Hoppock to the fire department. Alderman Bormann made a motion to accept the appointment. Alderman Million seconded the motion. On a call by the Mayor for ayes and nays the motions carried unanimously.

PRESENTATION OF CANCER SCREENING:

She also described two devices to be purchased through fundraising efforts: digital mammography machine and biopsy equipment. Alderman Parmeley suggested putting the pamphlets in the Welcome Wagon packets given out at City Hall to new utility customers.
