

Centralia Park Board Meeting Minutes (unapproved)

Tuesday, November 16, 2011

Centralia Recreation Center – 7:00 PM

Park Board Members Present: Mike Kinkead, Harold Ward, Richard Dickerson, Bev Reynolds, Laurie Peavler, Dale Davidson and Harold Beasley.

Meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM by Park Board President, Mike Kinkead.

Policies and Procedures for Centralia Recreation Center

Richard Dickerson moved that we implement a 3-month trial period that would reduce the age to enter the Fitness Area without the direct supervision of a parent or guardian from 17 years of age to a freshmen enrolled in high school with the stipulation that such a reduction would not increase the amount of liability insurance and both the student and parent/guardian sign the appropriate authorization form. Laurie Peavler seconded the motion.

The Board held open discussion

Richard Dickerson then made a motion to amend the previous motion by adding that the student must also complete a Fitness Area orientation provided by the Park Director before they would be allowed in the Fitness Area. Laurie Peavler seconded the motion. The Board voted 4-2 in favor of the amendment.

The Board voted in favor of the amended motion 4-2.

Items That May Arise

The Park Director informed the Board that he had been contacted about sponsoring the Rally Towels at the Centralia High School basketball games. The Board voted unanimously against the sponsorship.

The Park Director was approached by the Centralia High School softball team to begin their fundraising campaign specifically for new batting cages at Nathan A. Toalson Bicentennial Park. The Board unanimously approved such an effort contingent on Board approval of final design and that the batting cage would become the property of the Parks Department upon completion.

Meeting adjourned at 8:02 PM.
