## Lights:

# Activity Report for March 2024

- Did 55 locates
- Attended weekly dept. head meetings
- Attended city council mtg
- Spent several days hauling off brush and leaves at the drop off site
- Swept streets
- Sign work:
  - Installed 2 new stop signs at Rollins and Sneed to make the intersection a 4-way stop
  - Replaced 4 no parking signs
  - Replaced 1 stop sign
  - Repaired sign damaged from wind
- Trimmed and hauled off tree limbs around town
- Met with Matt and worked on the paving list for this year
- Street work:
  - Met with Coring and Cutting and had 12 areas cut for new expansion joint on Hampton dr.
  - Poured concrete to repair street cut in alley off of Switzler
  - Got a load of cold mix and spent several days patching potholes
  - Added some rock and smoothed up several alleys and shoulders
- Booth St. sidewalk:
  - Formed and poured walls on each side of box culvert
  - Formed and poured about 100ft of sidewalk
  - Installed handrail by the box culvert
- Drainage work:
  - Spent several days working on drainage around town
  - Cleaned out debris and poured concrete to repair storm sewer inlet on Lakeview
  - Installed 40ft of pipe for temporary driveway off of Cox St. for football field renovations
  - Removed old culvert and replaced with 24ft of 15in metal culvert at 700 n. Jefferson and started cleaning the ditch
  - Shot grade on several ditches
  - Met and talked with several homeowners about culverts and ditches
- Equipment maintenance:
  - Greased and cleaned backhoe and loader
  - Replaced the starter on 1 ton dump truck

- Repaired tailgate latch and cleaned up and repainted bed sides on 1 ton dump truck
- Cleaned and organized work truck
- Removed snowplow and spreader on 1 ton dump truck and on new dump truck
- Serviced grader, and 2 dump trucks
