- Swept streets

- Spent several days hauling off brush and leaves at the drop off site
- Hauled off debris pile at the street barn
- Checked and worked on drainage
- Watched 2 MIMRA training videos
- Trimmed tree limbs blocking signs
- Attended meeting at city hall with MODOT on the new round-a-bout
- Added rock and smoothed up several shoulders and alleys
- Met with contractor repairing street cut on Gano-chance
- Delivered lots of barricades for the tractor parade
- Decorated one of the dump trucks and put it into the Christmas tractor parade
- Called on 12/25/2023 for stop sign that had been run over and set temporary
- Equipment maintenance:
 - Worked on #10 (removed old controls, replaced door handle, replaced seals in fuel primer pump, installed strobe light on spreader)
 - Loaded and hooked up spreaders and snowplows on both dump trucks
 - Repaired lights on 2 trucks
- Sign work:
 - Installed 2 law enforcement only parking signs by the police station on Sneed St.
 - Replaced 13 crosswalk signs
 - Replaced 10 stop signs
 - Replaced 3 - 25mph signs
 - Replaced 1 yield sign
 - Built 7 new sign bases
