STREET DEPARTMENT Activity Report for October 2023

- Called out for tree limb blocking street on 10/1/2023
- Attended weekly dept. head meetings
- Attended city council mtg on 10/9/2023
- Hauled off some tree limbs that fell and blocked street
- Hauled barricades back to the shop after events downtown
- Did 79 locates
- Replaced 5 old stop signs
- Attended several IT meetings to interview and pick new IT company
- Spent several days hauling off brush and leaves at the drop off site
- Trimmed up tree limbs blocking signs and hanging into streets
- Met and talked with Bruce K. at Hubbell about installing a culvert
- Met and talked with Mr. Posey at 706 Green about culvert and ditch
- Checked culverts and talked with homeowner at 15 Leabrook
- Met with Travis Staat at 205 s. Howard Burton about widening driveway
- Took 1 ton truck to Woody's in Illinois to get plow and spreader installed
- Added some rock and smoothed up the teardrop at the city park
- Equipment maintenance:
 - Serviced, cleaned, and replaced cutting edges on the loader
 - Serviced the backhoe, work truck #91
 - o Got hydraulic cylinder for one of the snowplows repaired
 - o Repaired water leak on street sweeper
 - o Cleaned equipment
- Street maintenance:
 - Spent several days working with Christensen Asphalt to get streets prepped and paved
 - Paved Singleton St., 2 alleys downtown, all of Stone St., part of North St., all of Maple St., 1 block of Sims St., Parkview ct., 2 blocks of Howard Burton, part of Ann St., 2 blocks of Collier St., 1 block of Mitchell St., 1 block of Bradford St.

- Spent several days adding rock and smoothing up driveways and shoulders on streets that were paved
- Spent a few days laying out and painting parking lines and crosswalks on Singleton and Collier after they got paved
- Hauled and spread several loads of rock on Rowland
- Drainage work:
 - Dug out old culvert at 146 Burnett and set 36ft of 10in metal culvert and cleaned the ditch
 - Did some ditch cleaning on s. Green
 - Dug out and set 40ft of 10in metal culvert and cleaned ditch on North st for Hubbell
 - Dug out and added 15ft of 10in metal culvert to widen driveway in alley behind 706 Green
 - o Dug out and installed inlet on Tidball for Andrew Miller
 - Flushed culverts on Burnett
 - Spent several days digging out and hauling in rip-rap on Miles ditch between Miles and Booth
 - Dug out and added 10ft of 10in plastic culvert to widen the driveway at 205 s. Howard Burton
