Dog / Cat License If you own a dog and/or cat that is at least 5 months old, you are **required to obtain a City license for each animal "annually" January 1st to**



December 31st. To obtain a City animal license, please provide City Hall with a *current rabies vaccination record*. Dog licenses are \$2.00; cat licenses are \$2.00 if the cat has been spayed or neutered; \$15.00 if the cat has not been spayed or neutered. No household shall have more than 4 dogs *and/or* cats over the age of 5 months. All dogs are subject to the City's leash law. Veterans Day



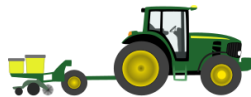
City Hall will be closed **Wednesday, November 11th** in observance of Veterans Day. However, trash routes will run **Wednesday, November 11th**.

- **Phone Numbers:** Please provide City Hall with a current phone number in case we need to contact you in an emergency.
- **Utility Bill Auto-Debit Program:** Payments will be deducted from your account on the 10th day of each month. For information, please contact City Hall or visit our website at www.centraliamo.org and click on "Forms/Publications".
- **City Website Online Account Access:** www.centraliamo.org. This access allows customers to view their most recent bill, access 12-month account history, and even pay their bill online using a debit/credit card with a 3% fee for using a card. Signing up for an account does not require the customer to make online payments, and there is no charge to create an account. If you need assistance obtaining your 4-digit account number to create an account, contact City Hall Staff.
